

Dear Quanta/ATCO/IEM Consortium –

Thank you for your message, pursuant to Section 5.3 of the Request for Proposals for Puerto Rico Electric Power Transmission and Distribution System (the “RFP”) issued on February 1, 2019, regarding the confidentiality of certain sections labeled as “confidential” or “proprietary” in your Definitive Proposal (as such term is defined in the RFP).

The Partnership Committee will be unable to provide a determination regarding your request prior to the Proposal Submission Deadline. In light of that, if you continue to have concerns regarding these matters, you may wish to consider submitting the Definitive Proposal on the condition that the sections labeled as “confidential” or “proprietary” are determined to be treated as confidential by the Partnership Committee. If you do so, include in the Definitive Proposal a written explanation of why such sections are to be treated as “confidential or “proprietary”, including why the disclosure of the information would be commercially harmful, specifically referring to any legal protection currently enjoyed by such information and why the disclosure of such information would not be necessary for the protection of the public interest.

Following your submission of the Definitive Proposal, the Partnership Committee shall (i) evaluate the sections labeled as “confidential” or “proprietary” in accordance with Articles 9(i) and 9(j) of Act 29, Act 120 and the corresponding sections of the Regulation, and (ii) provide written notification accepting or rejecting such confidentiality requests.

In the event that the Partnership Committee rejects such confidentiality requests or elects to disclose the requested materials, the Partnership Committee shall notify you and provide you the opportunity to request the immediate return of such materials (prior to any disclosure by the Partnership Committee) such that they will thereafter form no part of the Definitive Proposal.

Capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meaning set forth in the RFP.
